WHEN THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH COMES...




Cardinal Raniero Cantalamessa has been the Preacher to Popes and the Papal Household since 1980; he started with John Paul, was reappointed by Pope Benedict XVI and reconfirmed by Pope Francis who made him a Cardinal in 2020. Cardinal Cantalamessa has been a formidable and vocal advocate of the Holy Spirit both within and outside the Catholic Church. According to him, whatever the Holy Spirit touches, He changes; hence, the Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Holy Trinity whose presence in souls is visibly noticeable, and whose absence in anyone is palpably felt. It is the manifestation of that same Holy Spirit on the apostles that we commemorate today.

The word Pentecost comes from the Greek word Pentēkostē which means 'Fiftieth.' It refers to that Jewish festival (Shavuot) celebrated on the fiftieth day after Passover/Feast of Weeks/First Fruits (when Jews gave their first agricultural produce to the priests for them to be offered to God). For Christians, Pentecost refers to that preeminent event that occurred after 7 weeks of Easter - 50 days after the resurrection, when Christ sent the Holy Spirit on the apostles as He promised them in today's Gospel, thereby bringing to birth THE CHURCH! Yes, today is the Church's BIRTHDAY!!!

Whenever the Church has found herself in a tricky and/or fearful situation, she always calls on the Holy Spirit who is the Spirit of Truth and the disperser of fears as we hear in our Sunday Readings. The presence of the Holy Spirit is felt in our lives when we produce His fruits which include: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, trustfulness, gentleness and selfcontrol. The new Lectionary will use both the English Standard Version - Catholic Edition of the Bible and the Abbey Psalter for the psalms.

The New Lectionary will be a 4 Volume Set at £695, The Book of the Gospels will be One Set at £275.
