BE CONSISTENTLY VIGILANT

My dad was one of the young soldiers that fought in the Nigeria-Biafra Civil War. There are two crucial lessons he shared with me from that war. Firstly, my dad told me that wars will never be a way of resolving any conflicts and he would never want to be part of any war in his life time. Secondly, that during the war, thy were all taught a mantra which has accompanied him throughout his life. That mantra is: "WE ARE SURROUNDED BY ENEMIES; BE CONSISTENTLY VIGILANT." According to my dad, they were asked to repeat the above mantra as often as possible so as not to let their guards down and be routed by the enemies. It is this consistent vigilance that we are reminded of today.

At the end of today's parable of the wise and foolish virgins, from Matthew Chapter 25, Christ advised His disciples to stay awake. The Greek word used there is Gregoreité which comes from Gregoreo meaning to be attentively watchful of ourselves and events around us to avoid being taken unawares. To help us do this, we need the gift of Wisdom as our First reading tells us. One group of people who were consistently vigilant are the men and women who died fighting for the freedom we enjoy today. May we always remember them. Fr Johnpromise
