#### ARE WE 'PO-FACED' CATHOLICS?



There is one irrefutable observation that has always bothered me concerning Christians in general and Catholics in particular—Many of us wear gloomy looks while in Church, and I cannot wrap my head a round it. Is only only to be presented a round and solved in big presents? Or well as the control of the cont cannot be happy and relaxed in his presence? Or do we think God would be so mad at us if we are hapwe think God would be so mad at us if we are happy, smiley, and relaxed in His presence? I wonder why? On the 15th of November 2023, Pope Francis celebrated the 10th Anniversary of his 1st Apostolic Exhortation — *Evangelii Gaudium*, and sent us a clear but strong message: "The Christian message, as we have heard from the angel's words to the shepherds, is the proclamation of "a great joy"... Either we proclaim Jesus with joy, or we do not proclaim him, because another way of proclaiming him is not capable of bringing the true reality of him is not capable of bringing the true reality of Jesus. This is why a discontent Christian, a sad Christian, a dissatisfied, or worse still, resentful or rancorous Christian, is not credible.'

On this Gaudete Sunday when we are asked to rejoice always in the Lord, we look at the faces of Saint Teresa of Calcutta and Blessed Carlo Acutis, and remind ourselves that our God is a joyful one, and not a melancholic or sadistic God who is devoid of joy. Hence, when next we are at Mass, let our faces light-up; we are no 'Po-Faced 'Catholics. Yes, God wants to see our happy and smiley faces. Gaudete in Domino Semper! Fr Johnpromise
