### ACCOUNTABLE TO CEASAR & TO GOD

Since the publication of our parish financial statement last Sunday, a lot of parishioners have asked questions centring around 2 major issues that deserve to be responded to publicly. Firstly, SO PRIESTS ARE PAID SALARY/WAGES? The answer to this is NO. Salaries and wages must correspond to the enormity of work, the skills of the individual and present-day inflation. On the contrary, priests receive a monthly stipend from the parish they serve; for our diocese of Portsmouth and in this Fiscal Year, this is £418 per month. It is from this stipend that I pay my personal bills such as my medical prescriptions when I am sick, my dentist care, and my regular eye tests. It is equally from that stipend that I buy my personal clothes, shoes, pay for my annual holidays, my car insurance, contribute to my personal pension fund, help various UK and Nigerian Charities that are close to my heart, and assist my parents in Nigeria when they seek my help. Let us be honest, £418 per month is not a lot of money to live on; this is why parishioners are encouraged to assist their priests financially at Christmas and Easter and whenever they can.

Secondly, given what happened in the past, WILL FR JOHNPROMISE NOT OVERRIDE THE PARISH FI-NANCE COMMITTEE AND SPEND THE PARISH MONEY AS HE PLEASES? The answer to this is **NEVER.** Fiscal Responsibility is paramount to me from my professional background and I am not ready that mess that up now. Our diocese has a rule that for any parish that is in red, all projects that are above £2,000 cannot be initiated without the approval of the parish finance committee and the diocese; for parishes that are in black, that amount rises to £5,000. As your parish priest, I have appointed onto the PFC, men and women of integrity, who have the expertise to exercise the needed checks and balances. In line with my informed conscience and before God who will judge me, my promise to you is this: I will never spend your money without due clearance and authorisation. Fr Johnpromise has promised!!!
