Advent comes from the Latin words Advenire - To come to, or Adventus - Coming. ### **PARISH NOTICES**

PASTORAL LETTER FROM BISHOP PHILIP: After a few months away from the diocese, Bishop Philip is back from his Study Leave and Retreat. He sends his greetings to all of us for accompanying him with our prayers and best wishes. He has written us a Pastoral Letter to be read in all Sunday Masses within the Diocese of Portsmouth this weekend. Welcome Back, My Lord!!!

PARISH FINANCES: The first Parish Finance Committee meeting took place on 23rd Nov and a Budget for this year (2023-24) was agreed - Income (£134k), Expenditure (£162k). The Parish/Diocese Fiscal Year runs from September to August each year. For the first two months (Sept/Oct) our Income was £21,173 [Offertory (inc. SPF), £10,539; Hall, £3,864; OL Presb rent, £2,288; Tax Reclaim, £2,300; Other Income £2,182], and Expenditure is £20,692. The committee is aware of major repair and upgrade works that we will need to consider as well, subject to reserve funds being available to cover this. Presently we have an overall Parish balance of £38k credit. We are therefore asking all parishioners to consider what they can afford each week/month to contribute to the Parish. Please also make sure that if you are a tax payer that you have signed the new Diocese Gift Aid Form, in favour of the Catholic Diocese of Portsmouth (CDP). Thank you for your continued support of the Parish. — Michael Gallagher, Chair, Parish Finance Committee.

PARISH HEALING MASS & INTERNATIONA SUPPER:

Our Parish Healing Mass comes up on Saturday 2nd November 2023 at 4:30pm at Our Lady's Church. The Healing Mass commences at 4:30pm.
